



Call for Applications for Legal Researcher at the IJLS (on a contractual basis for a period of two years)

The Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies, a body corporate set up under the Institute for Judicial and Legal Studies Act 2011 and under the aegis of the Judiciary, is inviting applications from eligible candidates in Mauritius as Legal Researcher for a period of two years (*renewable*) at the Institute.

Candidates must hold a recognized law degree. They should be computer literate and fluent in English and French. Experience in the legal field is desirable.

A monthly salary of Rs25,525/- will be paid to the successful candidate. The equivalent of two months' salary will also be paid on completion of twelve months' satisfactory service. The contract may be terminated in case of misconduct or unsatisfactory performance.

Legal Researchers, in addition to fixed emoluments, will benefit from the intellectual discourses which take place at the IJLS through the medium of CPD courses as well as workshops on policy issues for professional development, taught by local and internationally renowned scholars and policy experts.
